

CHURCH CAMPING RETREAT 2023!

We are having a church camping retreat for the purposes of

Dates: The evening of Friday, July 14 through Sunday morning, July 16

Registration Deadline: Monday, June 26

Registrations received after June 26: Add \$10 per person

Registration will be open from June 1-June 26. Watch the church announcements for details.

Costs:

\$60 per person

\$35 per person if you bring your own tent to sleep in

\$30 per person for all Dwelling Place residents (Ferguson, Herkimer, Verne Barry, etc.)

\$250 cap for a family of 5 or more

Children under the age of 3 are free

(If you need scholarship help, SIGN UP TO VOLUNTEER TO HELP WITH THE CHURCH YARD SALE ON FRI, JUNE 2 OR SAT, JUNE 3.)

Arrival Time: Friday night between 3:00 p.m.-6:00 p.m. (If you will be arriving later than 6:00 p.m., please indicate that on your registration form.)

Departure Times: Sunday after the morning Camp Meeting (around 11:30 a.m.)

Location: 6889 Pine Island Dr NE, Comstock Park, MI 49321

Ages: All ages are welcome. Children under age 18 must attend with parent or guardian.

Answers to Your Questions:

Q: Where will we sleep?

A: We are staying in cabins. Most cabins are simple bunk rooms with 2-3 bunkbeds in them. For "Michigan" and "Indiana" bunk houses, bathrooms are in the same building, just in the hallway. For "Cedar Lodge," there is a toilet in each room, with showers down the hall.

Q: Is there electricity?

A: Yes! Each bunk house has electricity, plumbing, walls, a roof, and a bed!

Q: Do I need to bring my own sheets/blanket/sleeping bag/pillow?

A: Yes!

Q: Is food provided?

A: Yes! All meals will be provided. Each person will help with preparing or cleaning up a meal.

Q: Will there be a spiritual part to this camp?

A: Yes! Santes Beatty will be our special camp speaker! He will speak on Friday night, Saturday night, and Sunday morning. We want you to rest, be refreshed, and have a meaningful time connecting with God!

Q: What about alcohol, marijuana, other substances, gambling games, etc?

A: You know the drill. It's church camp! Plus you don't need it anyway. None of that is permitted on this trip.

Q: May I bring people with me who are not part of City Life?

A: Yes, but they must abide by our code of conduct. Also, you will need to identify that they are "Guests of City Life" when you complete the registration.

Q: Who can I room with?

A: There are a few options.

--You might have the option to have a bunk room to yourself, depending on number of people.

--It's best if you can identify a roommate.

--Unmarried people of the opposite sex may not share a room.

--We cannot guarantee that you will have a room to yourself, but we can try to accommodate it if possible. Just know that we can't promise this.

Q: How many people are per room?

A: It depends. There are multiple options. You can see the Registration Specialist to see the options.

Q: May I bring pets?

A: No.

Q: Is transportation provided to the camp?

A: Yes. If you need a ride, you can sign up for pickup by the church van, and we will coordinate details with you.
