OPPORTUNITIES:

IMMIGRANT CONNECTION

Immigrant Connection is dedicated to building a community of inclusion by providing low-cost legal services to immigrants to secure permanent residency and citizenship. Our hope is that by assisting eligible immigrants to obtain permanent legal residency they will experience greater access to employment, education, housing, and health services. Our entire community and economy benefit when individuals experience stability and opportunities. Volunteer opportunities may include simple office tasks, filing, flyer distribution, social media development, and fundraising.
